Road Map for Stream System Integrity

West coast research in the 1990s by Horner et al at the Center for Urban Water Resources Management in Seattle applied a systems approach and demonstrated that the order-of-priority for factors limiting ecological values of urban streams is:

 LIMITING FACTOR 1: Changes in Watershed Hydrology addressed thru the Water Balance Accounting Pillar
LIMITING FACTOR 2: Disturbance and /or Loss of Integrity of Riparian Corridor addressed through the Ecological Accounting Pillar

LIMITING FACTOR 3: Degradation and/or Loss of Aquatic Habitat within the Stream LIMITING FACTOR 4: Deterioration of Water Quality
